This large-format board book takes little readers on a colourful journey through the week. From grocery shopping on Monday morning to the doctor's appointment on Wednesday to the garden party on Sunday evening – with its friends Mouse, Hare, Badger, Beaver, Owl, Fox, Squirrel, and Raccoon, the little Duck goes on great adventures surrounding the duck house, garden, and pond. The view of the setting from above at the beginning of the book encourages to flip back and forth to discover something new every time.



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## Creative People:



**Author:** Norman Klaar was born in the beautiful Rhineland in-between the then capital city Bonn and the cathedral city Cologne in 1980. Today, he writes books for children and tries teaching himself how to draw.



**Illustrator:** Sébastien Braun was born in Strasbourg, the hometown of Gustave Doré and Tomi Ungerer (his heroes). As a child he spent countless hours drawing, but at secondary school there were no art classes, so he filled his homework with doodles and portraits of his teachers. At university he initially studied history – fortunately, the building was shared with the art department, and when he saw the students sketching, knew he had to change. After that, he spent a few years teaching applied art to sixth formers, before taking the plunge as a freelance illustrator. His first commissions were for magazines in Paris, and when he moved to London, he developed his portfolio for children's books.



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
